## What is Taking the Reins

Taking the Reins is an Equine Facilitated Learning (EFL) project, based in Warwickshire, offering EFL sessions to disabled and disadvantaged children and young people from across the UK.

At the heart of EFL is the concept that peoples' lives can be positively influenced and permanently changed by spending time with horses. The key idea focuses on a child learning to bond and effectively communicate with a horse or pony.

Anyone can take part in an EFL session and achieve positive results. Even if a person does not have a particular area of their life that they wish to change, the horses' honest reaction to a person's actions and behaviour can often give us insight into ourselves and our true feelings that we might not otherwise have.
