Circles Network Small Groups are specialist small groups for children and young people aged 7–19 with disabilities and / or autism living in Peterborough.

These groups are designed for those with higher levels of need who benefit from additional support, including medical, behavioural, or emotional support. Low group numbers and a high staff-to-member ratio ensure personalised care and a safe, regulated environment. All activities are person-centred and designed around each young person's interests and needs, with a focus on achieving positive outcomes. Our youth workers provide close support and guidance, helping members get the most from every session in a safe, caring, and fun environment.

Please note: these groups are accessed via a panel agreement following a needs assessment by a social worker.

SESSIONS

- support members to develop communication and social interaction skills
- offer meaningful, enjoyable activities tailored to each person's needs and interests
- build confidence, independence, and friendships
- provide a safe space away from family, supported by experienced staff
- create a fun, supportive, and inclusive environment
